Re: Hurricane Creek Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant Update

The Hurricane Creek Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant is continuing to progress on the west side of US 75. The site work construction team has completed the site clearing and has constructed the temporary construction road in the County Road 286 right-of-way.

Last month, the City completed the purchase of the property. This week, the City received the official permit documents from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), including the approved discharge permit for up to four million gallons per day. This is the critical permit required to construct and operate the plant.

On June 8, the City held a pre-proposal meeting with construction companies interested in bidding on the installation of the plant. There was significant interest, and we expect to have a very competitive process. The deadline for proposal submittals is June 29. We expect to complete a review of the proposals in July and bring a contract for the treatment plant construction to the City Council in August.

Staff have been in contact with our regional partners on the schedule and timing of plant operations as we look forward to bringing this critical facility to the area. The partnerships with our neighboring communities will help to subsidize the treatment costs and allow Anna to provide the best value in cost for wastewater treatment.
