Re: City Crime Statistics and Map

The Anna Police Department is now publishing crime data on the City's website under Reports and Statistics on the police department About Us page. The reports will display the previous month's crime statistics along with comparisons to the prior year. Additionally, there is a link to a map which plots the data geographically for Part-A Crimes, Narcotics Offenses, Arrests and Disturbances. The map is interactive and allows the viewer to click on an icon to view the date, time, call type, and incident number. Each icon corresponds with a legend and there is a bar graph at the bottom that displays raw numbers. Some call types such as traffic stops, accidents, alarms, etc. have been excluded from the map for ease of viewing. The crime report and map will both be updated monthly.

The police department began compiling the data to provide the reports in 2022 to be able to publish year-over-year comparisons. It should be noted that there will be swings in reported numbers, both up and down, because we are reporting relatively small numbers of criminal offenses.
