Re: Municipal Complex Roadwork and Access

Beginning on May 6, vehicular access to the Municipal Complex will change to accommodate 7th Street being closed for roadwork. Access to the Municipal Complex will be from FM 455 to Riggins Street where vehicles can enter through the east parking lot entrance adjacent to the police parking lot. A map showing the temporary traffic pattern is attached. This traffic pattern will remain until 7th Street is complete, which staff currently estimate to be mid-June. Once completed, access will switch back to normal and Riggins will be closed from 5th Street to 7th Street to allow construction staging for the library. The project will be completed in August, weather permitting.
