Re: Scenic City Silver Level Designation

The City of Anna has been designated a Scenic City at the Silver Level from Scenic Texas, Inc. in recognition of plans, policies, and ordinances that support having an attractive city

Scenic Texas is a nonprofit organization that was founded in 1985. Texas cities utilize the organization's diagnostic program for an objective review of existing municipal infrastructure ordinances as they relate to public roadways and public spaces. The evaluation compares the applicant city's standards to the unique Scenic City model devised by partnership organizations. The assessment is points-based, with every applicant city receiving a detailed, scored evaluation. Official certification can be earned by the cities that score in the upper range and meet stringent scenic streetscape standards. There are four levels of Scenic City certification: Recognized, Silver, Gold, and Platinum.

On Thursday, October 10th, during the annual Texas Municipal League Conference, the City of Anna will be recognized during Scenic City's annual awards reception. The members of City Council attending the conference are encouraged to attend.
