

# User Guide for Anna's Interactive GIS Map


Once you launch Anna's interactive Map, just click "I Accept" to acknowledge the Disclaimer and begin.




On the left-hand side of the screen is a toolbar with various options to help navigate the map, view different layers, share, and print.

-  Zoom In
-  Return to the Initial Map Extent
-  Zoom Out
-  Zoom to your Location
-  Open the Map Legend
-  Turn Layers On or Off
-  Measuring Tool
-  Share the Map
-  Print
-  Bookmarks


Use the Layers tab to turn map layers on and off:




Click on the map to see more information about the data that is there. Use the arrow to click through to see the additional windows.





Use the Search Bar at the top, right corner to search for an address.





Or, click the drop-down arrow next to the search bar to search a specific layer such as Subdivisions or Parcels.





Use the Print tool to export your map to a PDF or image to print.



To use the Measuring Tool, pick whether you want to measure an area or a straight line. Then choose the unit type from the drop-down list.



Once you have picked the unit method, click on the map where you want to start measuring and then double-click at the end to end your measurement. To measure an area, continue to click to draw the outline of the area that you are measuring and double click to complete it.
