



1. Bulky items are any large items that do not fit in your trash container with the lid closed.
2. A disposal fee will be charged for an excessive number of bulky items. Please contact CARDS if you need additional bulk pick ups.
3. Bulky items should fit into an area that is equal to or less that 3 cubic yards or 81 cubic feet.



Acceptable Items

- Floor covering/Carpet (cannot exceed 4 feet or 50 pounds, must be bundled)
- Brush/Branches (cannot exceed 4 feet or 50 pounds, must be bundled)
- Glass or mirror (cannot exceed 4 feet in any dimension)
- Mattress or compressible items
- Packaging material (no loose Styrofoam, it must be bagged)
- Furniture
- Grills (no propane tanks)
- Lawn furniture
- Lawn mowers
- Bicycles
- Home exercise equipment under 50lbs
- Hot water heaters (must be empty)
- Household appliances (Washer, Dryer, etc.)
- Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners
(These items will not be collected by CARDS unless proof of freon evacuation is submitted and verified prior to collection date. The NTMWD Regional Disposal Facility will not take these items without an evacuation certificate.)



Restricted Items

• Household Hazardous Waste

The City of Anna and CARDS will have two recycling events per year, generally in the spring and fall, starting in 2021. Keep an eye out for schedule events. If you cannot wait until a scheduled even you can coordinate with NTMWD Melissa Landfill for a fee. Information on NTMWD's landfill is available here:
