RED YUCCA

Hesperaloe parviflora

Water: Low
Heat Tolerance: High
Size: 1-2 feet
Grow Period: Spring, Summer



TEXAS SAGE

Leucophyllum frutescens

Water: Low
Heat Tolerance: High
Exposure: Sun, Partial Sun
Grow Period: Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter



MEXICAN MINT MARRIGOLD

Tagetes lucida

Water: Low
Heat Tolerance: High
Size: 2-3 feet
Grow Period: Summer, Fall



TEXAS LANTANA

Lantana urticoides

Water: Low
Heat Tolerance: High
Size: 1-6 feet
Grow Period: Spring, Summer, Fall



PRICKLY PEAR

Opuntia ellisiana

Water: Low
Heat Tolerance: High
Size: 2-3 feet
Grow Period: Summer



AMERICAN BEAUTYBERRY

Callicarpa americana

Water: Low
Heat Tolerance: High
Size: 4-8 feet
Grow Period: Summer
