

Protect yourself from mosquito bites.

Mosquitoes spread diseases and can bite at anytime. Follow these helpful tips to protect you and your family.



Keep mosquitoes outside.

Maintain screens on all windows and repair any holes. Use air conditioning.



Stop mosquitoes from breeding.

Put away items that could hold standing water. As little as one teaspoon of water for more than one week is enough for mosquitoes to breed.

Common sources of standing water:

- Gutters
- Flowerpots
- Pet Dishes
- Birdbaths
- Tires
- Trash Cans
- Buckets



Wear insect repellent when outdoors.

Use products with active ingredients that are safe and effective.



Wear protective clothing.

Wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants when outdoors.
