Does the city offer Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and E-recycling?

The City of Anna provides HHW and e-recycling each year in the spring and fall. Please visit online for dates and times.

How do I dispose of my Christmas Trees?

Bulky Items and Yard Waste

Please call CARDS Recycling if you have a question regarding this service at **877-592-2737**. This service is once a month.



Guidelines

- Have your poly cart(s) set out & ready for collection by 7 a.m. on your collection day. You may place your carts(s) out as early as 6 p.m. the day prior to pick-up.
- Place carts(s) at least three feet apart from other carts, mailboxes, vehicles, utility meters, poles, fences, etc.
- Trash items should be bagged with the cart lid closed to prevent spillage.
- Recycling items should be loose in the container or placed in brown paper bags.
- Cardboard must be broken down and placed loosely within the recycling cart.
- An overloaded container or mixed with bags of trash will result in non-collection.
- All recycling must be inside the container with the lid closed. Items outside of the container will not be collected.
- CARDS sends out different trucks for each type of pickup. Pick-up service may not be completed until 7 p.m.
- For those needing an additional cart, please call Utility Billing at 972-924-2432 and one can be provided for an additional fee of \$7 per month.

Accepted Items

Items for recycling must be empty, clean and dry, and placed loosely in your recycling cart (no plastic bags). CARDS Recycling accepts the following items for recycling:

Metal

- Clean aluminum cans, foil and pans
- Steel (tin) food cans
- Pots, pans and scrap metal

Paper / Cardboard

- Newspaper, magazines and catalogs
- Thin cardboard boxes, chipboard, boxboard (cereal, shoe boxes, etc.)
- Milk and juice cartons (must be rinsed clean)
- Clean pizza boxes (without food or grease residue)
- Old documents, junk mail, mixed office paper, school papers and non-metallic paper gift wrap (must be larger than a credit card).
- Paper grocery bags
- Phone books
- Shredded paper (bagged or loose)
- Small corrugated cardboard boxes (must be emptied and free of plastic and Styrofoam Plastic)

Plastic

- Plastic drink bottles, jugs and containers (must be stamped 1, 2 or 5 (lids can be loosely attached)
- Product bottles; shampoo, detergent, etc.. (must be rinsed clean)
- Plastic bags

Glass

- Glass containers used in food and beverage packaging
- Ceramics (dishes, drinking glasses and vases)

Restricted Items

Glass

Items such as light bulbs/fluorescent tubes, and mirrors

Metal

Items such as aerosol cans and wire hangers

Paper / Cardboard

Facial or toilet tissue, paper towels, self-sticking notes (due to glue)

Plastic

CDs/DVDs, plastic wrap, plastic containers used for motor oil, antifreeze or other hazardous materials, plastic toys, metallic and cellophane gift wrap, trash bags, and Styrofoam (packaging, peanuts, cups, etc.).

Other items not accepted in Recycling

Adult and baby diapers, carpet or rugs, tile, fabric, clothing, shoes and yard waste (soil, limb, grass clippings, etc..).

Missed Pick Up

If your trash, recycling, bulky items or yard waste was out by 7 a.m. and not collected by end of day, call CARDS at **877-592-2737**.

CONTAINER DON'TS



Containers must remain upright for pickup

Keep all materials inside the container

Do not place containers back-to-back

Keep container clear of all obstructions
